RE-REGISTRATION FOR 2020-21

Effective February 1, all families returning to Strathcona Christian Academy (Grades 1-12) will need to complete two steps to confirm enrollment for 2020-2021:

1.) The first step is to re-register with Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS). Please complete the online Returning Student Registration Form - available by logging in to the PowerSchool Parent Portal between February 1-29 (see Page 2 of this newsletter for full details).

2.) The second step is to complete the Society Fees process. All current families (including families with kindergarten siblings) will receive a DocuSign Package via email beginning March 1. If one of more of your children are not returning to SCA in September 2020, please decline the DocuSign invitation to sign, and email <u>charlene.gagne@eips.ca</u> to confirm your decision not to return.

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION BEGINS FEBRUARY 1, 2020!

Is your child turning five on or before December 31, 2020? If so, its now time to register for kindergarten.

To register, simply complete the online registration form at <u>www.eips.ca/kindergarten</u>.

Complete the Returning Student Registration: February 1-29

Elk Island Public Schools' (EIPS) returning student registration process will be open Saturday, February 1st at 9am. All returning students must complete the online Returning Student Registration Form to confirm their child's enrolment in a school for the upcoming 2020-21 school year. Additionally, students who want to attend a non-designated school need to make that request through the returning student registration process—acceptance is based on available space.

All returning EIPS students are required to complete the form by Feb. 29, 2020.

Access to the Returning Student Registration Form is provided through the PowerSchool Parent Portal. If you don't have a PowerSchool Parent Portal account, you need to set one up before February 1, 2020.

Measuring our Success: Complete the Accountability Pillar Survey

Once again, Alberta Education is conducting its Accountability Pillar Survey. Every year, Alberta Education conducts the survey to gather information about the quality of education provided by Alberta schools and school authorities.

Grade 4 students are completing the survey online at the school. Student participation is completely anonymous.

Additionally, parents and guardians of students in grades 4, 7 and 10 are also asked to take a survey, either online or by mail. Information about the survey was sent to these families in January. Like the student and teacher survey, it's anonymous and asks questions about your school experiences. If you have a child in grades 4, 7 or 10, we encourage you to participate. The survey deadline is Feb. 28, 2020.

Results from the Accountability Survey are provided to Elk Island Public Schools each May. The Division then uses the data to inform its four-year education plan, its annual school education plans and strategies for continuous improvement.
