GRADES 1-12 RE-REGISTRATION FOR 2020-21

For students entering grades 1-12 in September 2020, re-registration will involve 2 steps:

- 1.) From February 1-29, 2020, all grade 1-12 students will be required to re-register with EIPS for the 2020-2021 school year. This re-registration form will be available through your Parent Portal account. Instructions will be sent out from EIPS in January 2020.
