- 5 Duo-tangs with fold back pins, plastic, variety of colors
- 4 pocket folders, plastic
- 10 8.5 x 11 scribbles (full size, **no** coils, **no** perforated sheets, 80 pages)
- 1 pkg looseleaf, 3 hole, 200-250 sheets/pkg (unopened, not in binders)
- 2 eraser (White is preferred, i.e. EF vinyl. No "toy" erasers, please)
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 20 HB pencils (Ticonderoga or Blue Staedtler preferred)
- 1 pkg. pencil crayons (no felt pens), 24/pkg - please bring to school sharpened
- 1 soft pencil case (no plastic boxes, please)

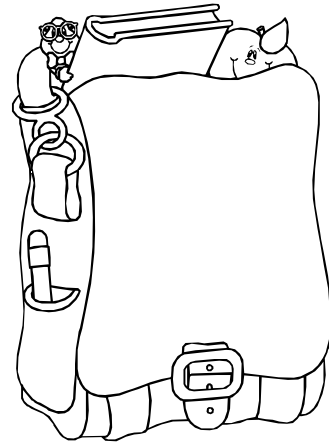

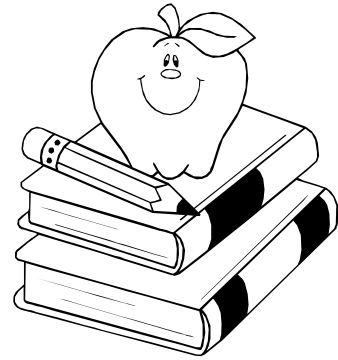
