Contacting Your Child's Teacher We recently made changes to how families can contact our teachers. If you'd like to reach out to your child's teacher directly, simply log in to your <u>PowerSchool Parent</u> <u>Portal</u> account. From the Grades and Attendance page, you can click on the name of any of your child's teachers to email them directly as needed. To connect with school administration and main office staff, refer to the <u>contact form</u> located on our school's webpage. From the online contact form, you can also send an email to report your child's absence. If you're having trouble with your PowerSchool account, contact the school office. And, of course, we're always just a phone call away if you have questions or need assistance, 780-449-2787.

Please Give us a Hand!

Throughout the school day, we receive many, many calls to our office from parents with reminders for students or alternate arrangements for transportation. We recognize that on occasion our families will have emergencies or unexpected changes and will need to call us with these changes - and we are happy to help.

When we call in to relay a message to the students, it is a disruption to classroom instruction. We also receive many calls right at the end of the day and are faced with a frantic rush to get the message to a child at the last minute.

If your child has an appointment and will need to be picked up early, or have a change to your routine, we ask that you please send a note in with your child for the teacher. We would also ask that you remind your children in the morning or give them a reminder note that they can refer to if there are any changes to their daily routine.

Thank you in advance for helping us reduce the interruptions to our classrooms.

Inclement Weather

With the winter season almost here, we want to remind families to dress children appropriately for the weather when getting ready for school or the bus. The weather often changes unexpectedly throughout the day, so please select suitable outerwear and ensure your child is prepared for changing conditions.

If inclement weather conditions occur, Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS) advises families of any bus cancellations using various communications tools—automated-telephone messages, alerts posted on www.eips.ca and school websites, Twitter, Facebook, local radio stations, and notification through both the Bus Status and the Ride 360 apps. Morning bus cancellations are posted on www.eips.ca by 6:30 a.m.

Decisions regarding bus cancellations are guided by EIPS administrative procedures that state, "school bus service may be suspended...when there is a forecast or current temperature of -40 C, including wind chill factor, in one or more regions." Other reasons for suspending or delaying school bus services include adverse weather and poor road conditions. When school bus services are suspended, schools remain open to students. EIPS believes families have the right and responsibility to make choices for their children based on their beliefs and perceptions of safety during times of inclement weather.
