Share Your Thoughts on Budget Planning for 2025-26

Alberta Education allocates funds to school boards to fulfill their delegated responsibilities of providing education programs for students in kindergarten to Grade 12. As part of Elk Island Public Schools' (EIPS) commitment to stakeholder engagement and to continue allocating resources according to local priorities, the Division conducts an annual budget planning survey to seek input from staff, families Grade 12 students and community partners.

The survey is voluntary, anonymous and takes about five to 10 minutes to complete. The survey questions suggest possible budget areas for EIPS to focus its resources, which align with the Division's current <u>Four-Year Education Plan</u>. If you believe there are other areas where the Division should concentrate its resources, you can also indicate what these are. EIPS will consider all budget planning input to guide future decision-making.

HELP US HELP YOU!

REPORTING STUDENT ABSENCES, EARLY PICKUPS AND END OF DAY CHANGES

Parents, we ask you to help our office and teaching staff when it comes to reporting absences, early pick ups and changes to end of day transportation. We do appreciate your punctual communication in these situations!

Below you will find a handy guide to help you navigate what steps to take in these scenarios.

REPORTING AN ABSENCE

If it is a **planned** absence (you know in advance of the day): <u>Email the teacher directly</u>. Alternatively, you could send a note in with your child.

If it is a last-minute absence (unplanned): Call or email the school office.

REPORTING AN EARLY PICK-UP

If it is a **planned** early pick-up (*you know in advance of the day*): <u>Email the teacher directly</u>. Alternatively, you could send a note in with your child.

If it is a last-minute early pick-up (unplanned): <u>Call or email the school office.</u>

Please note, **we will dismiss your child upon your arrival at the school.** Once you arrive at the school, please call the school office or pop in to ask for your child to be dismissed. **Please plan to give yourself some extra time to allow for their dismissal.**

REPORTING A CHANGE IN END OF DAY TRANSPORTATION

If it is a **planned** change in end of day transportation (you know in advance of the day): <u>Email the teacher directly</u>.

Alternatively, you could send a note in with your child.

If it is a **last-minute** change in end of day transportation (unplanned): <u>Call or email the school</u> <u>office **by 2:00 pm**</u>.

The earlier you can let us know, the better.

There is a lot going on in the school office every day and we do our best to ensure parent messages are passed on. However, when messages come to the office after 2:00 pm, we cannot guarantee that your message will be passed on in time.

HAS YOUR CONTACT INFORMATION RECENTLY CHANGED?

Have you recently moved or has your contact information changed since the start of the year?

SCA Elementary encourages families to review the information the Division has on file to ensure it's up to date. Using the **Student Information Update** available through the <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u>, families can review the current information on file for each student—including addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, parent and guardian information, emergency contacts, medical details and other related information—and submit any updates needed.

Reviewing and updating the form ensures the school and Division have the most up-to-date information regarding your child. **Updates completed by December 10 are especially** helpful as the Division prepares for 2025-26 registration processes beginning in the new year.

NOTE: Only submit updates for the changes that have already taken place. If you're moving later this school year, you'll submit the necessary updates to your information through the **Student Information Update** after you've moved.
